





Dear Families

I hope you had a lovely Easter break and managed to see some sunshine. The children have returned to school rearing to go, showing enthusiasm with their learning which has been lovely to see.

I recently sent you all a copy of our updated and reviewed Relationship and Behaviour Policy. A copy of this can be found on our website under the policy section. If you have any questions about this policy, then please let me know. I am usually out on the playground at the beginning of each school day or alternatively you can send an email to the school office for my attention.

The school day ends at 3.20 and we expect all children to be collected at this time. If a family member is late, the school is currently paying a member of staff to supervise the child until they are collected. This is having a significant impact on the school and those children who are consistently picked up after 3.20pm. For these reasons and to ensure that your children continue to be safe we have updated our Late Collection policy. The new policy has some significant changes. Please read the new policy so that you are aware of these changes and can take steps to ensure that you collect your children at 3.20pm. The updated policy will be sent to you today.

Thank you to everyone in our community who supported with the Pond and Allotment Tidy Up on Monday 8th April. Along with members of our community which included families, staff and local councillor's, we also had support from a team from Bluewater who helped us to clear both areas. It was a beautiful sunny day which meant that the team got both areas sorted and ready for planters, shed, greenhouse and plants to be ordered and installed. If you would like to be part of the working party for the next phase of this project, then please let the office team know. I will continue to keep you updated.

Can I please remind all family members to be respectful when parking a car. We have several residents who struggle to get off their driveways because they have been blocked in. I understand that for many family members they are only parking for '5 mins' but for our residents the 5 mins means that they are late for important appointments. Please be courteous and park safely.








Rise and Shine it's breakfast Time at Knockhall!!!


From 15th April we are inviting ALL children to come along to the school Breakfast Club which will run every day from Monday to Friday from 0800-0840am




