It has been lovely to see you all for Parent Consultations and hear from the children how well they are getting on. Thank you to the teaching team for providing lovely feed back to our families.

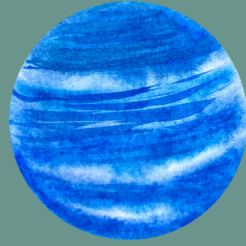
The first Growing Together-Regeneration Project meeting took place on Monday with members of our PTFA and Local Academy Committee. There is now a plan in place to get both the pond area and the allotment cleared and ready for planting and new furniture. This is an exciting project so please let us know if you would like to be part of the working group.

I have been reviewing the end of day routine for Nursery and Reception classes and have noticed how congested the outside area can get. There are times when it is difficult for Knockhall adults to see family members and that means that children can not be released. There are also times when children get lost in amongst the crowds which means that they are not safe. To ensure the safety of our youngest children, the gates that run between the reception area and outside Nurture room will be locked. Parents of children in EYFS will be able to come into the outside area but will need to exit the area and walk around the main walkway to other areas of the school. This will mean that the main walkway between the EYFS gate and the KS1 playground will be busy. Please be kind to each other and make space where you can. I will monitor things and implement a one-way system around the school if needed.

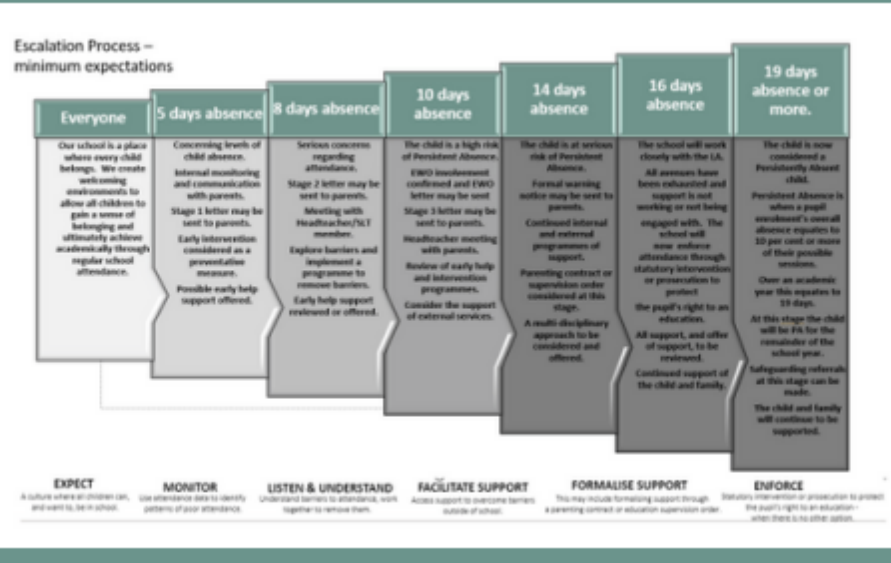
