The school echoed with angelic voices and melodies. The audience included our KS2 classes, teachers and some parents. It was truly a magical time.












rear o Parrots are continuing to work on teamwork through passing the ball during their game of handball in PE. This week they are aiming to be the team who has possession of the ball the most.


