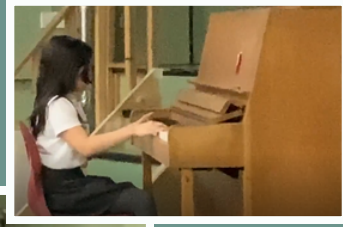

Year 6 Parrots are continuing to work on teamwork through passing the ball during their game of handball in PE. This week they are aiming to be the team who has possession of the ball the most.



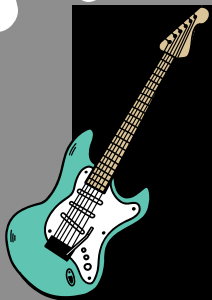

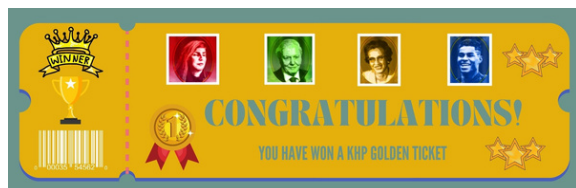

Teamwork - Well done to our year 5/6 girls football team who displayed amazing teamwork in their match against Maypole Primary School.

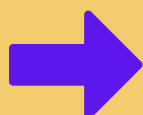
Pride - We are very proud of the work the children have done this week for World Book Day - some fantastic learning all round!
