Literacy

We will be learning all about the books on the right. The Three Little Pigs will form a large part of this and we will support the children with learning the story and beginning their understanding of story structures. We will learn to use and draw story maps to aid us in remembering and sequencing stories. We will also continue to develop our name recognition and writing our names correctly with correct letter formation.

Mathematics

We are beginning to explore pattern, shape and numbers to 5. There will be a range of activities available within the classroom provision to support this and for the children to become familiar with these early mathematical concepts. Daily Maths Meets are used to support basic skills like days of the week, months of the year, seasons or so on.

Understanding the World

Through the key texts displayed, we will explore the world around us, developing our understanding of our topic Me, My Family, My Home. We will celebrate the differences between each of us through the observations we make. We will also learn about different homes and traditions and how we are all unique.



Expressive Art and Design

Tools, materials and media will be used carefully and with increasing control. We will learn how to use a variety of techniques whilst exploring with colour. We will begin to express ourselves through songs, rhymes and role play activities.

Physical Development

PE takes place each week and is a great way to develop gross motor controls, particularly throwing and catching a large ball as we are currently practicing. We will also use balance and co-ordination games to develop Physical Development. Fine motor control will be developed through different malleable experiences like play dough, using tweezers and paintbrushes. This will in turn, develop pencil control further.
