This term Big Bang Day will be on November 5th – Children are invited to come dressed as a hero of their choice – this could be a superhero or a real-life hero (emergency services). We will be designing their own superhero, creating a superhero mask and making their own comic book strips.

Trip/ Visit

Our children will be learning to create a first person narrative from the perspective of Hogarth meeting the Iron Man. We

will be focussing on suspense and creating character description using show not tell. In our non-fiction writing, we will be writing a newspaper report, using direct and indirect speech.

We will be looking at personal boundaries and how to safely respond to others. We will be discussing what makes a good friend and the impact of hurtful behaviour.

Animal Aid Workshop Better Planet Workshop

We will be continuing with addition and subtraction with a focus on adding and subtracting three digit numbers including Maths exchanging. Wewill then move on to multiplication and division focussing on the 3,4 and 8 times table. Our learning will focus on forces and magnets. We will be learning how a push or pull is exerted by something. We will Science also learn about magnets, how they're used and which materials are magnetic or non-magnetic. We we will be completing a local history study, looking at significant events which casused the beginning of the NHS, History police force and the fire brigade. We will look at how these sevices have changed over time. In this unit, children will build on their knowledge of primary and secondary colours to explore tertiary colours. Using Art/DT Andy Warhol as their artist focus, they will create their own piece of art in the style of Andy Warhol, predicting which colours to mix to create their desired effect. The children will be introduced to subjet specific vocabulary, using the glockenspiel to put their understanding into Music practice. Computing Children will be using iMovie and learning how to use green screen. We will continue our learning arund the question 'What do different people believe about God?' This will involve looking R.E. at different religions such as Hinduism, Islam and Christianity and learning about their similarities and differences. The children will be learning how to co-operate as a team learning invaluable skills for passing and teamwork while P.E. practicing netball and tag rugby.
