English

This term pupils will be writing a historical tale using their knowledge of Ancient Egypt. They will also write a non chronological report to showcase their knowledge of Ancient Egypt.

Maths

Number - Children will be focusing on multiplication and division. Children will learn how to use formal methods for this kind of work

History/Geography

In History, we will be exploring the Ancient Egypt. We will be focusing on the location of Egypt globally and also looking at key geographical features within Egypt as well as features of everyday life for a person living in that era.

Art/DT

This term, the children will further develop their drawing skills by accurately identifying and rendering 2D and 3D shapes when drawing from observation or second-hand sources.

Music

This term the children will be learning how to use the glockenspiel to create Egyptian music.

Computing

The children will be designing a presentation and creating mock-ups for apps using Keynote.

R.E.

This term the focus is Hinduism. Pupils will look into what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today, including Diwali.

P.E.

This term the children will be focusing on netball and Tag Rugby. The children will enhance their passing and shooting skills along with improving their ability to work as part of a team.
