English

Our core text will be Holes by Louis Sachar. We will be learning how to write a balanced argument on whether Camp Greenlake is a suitable place to send for teenagers. We will also be writing a monologue as one of the characters in the text. We aim to share the experiences and the feelings of the character as they recount their time.

Maths

We will continue to embed our knowledge of the year 6 curriculum. We will begin the term with shape and measures before moving onto consolidation of the topics taught so far.

Geography/ History

We will be looking into the history of the criminal justice system. We will be researching social history and how society have developed laws over time.

Art/DI

They will be inspired from their topic, Crime and Punishment and their core text Holes to create their own piece of digital street art showcasing a societal message which they will strongly about.

PHSE

This term the focus is on independence. Pupils will focus on resilience, money debt and well-being, and tolerance.
