Our Learning Overview

Key Texts



English

We will start this term look at our fiction text 'The Moon Dragons'. Using this book we will explore how to innovate, imitate and apply our learning including creating our own dragons through descriptive writing.

Maths

We will start the term with a measurement unit, focusing on money. Children will expand their knowledge of notes and coins, as well as develop awareness of giving change and comparing amounts. We will then move onto multiplication and division where we will focus on 2s 5s and 10s timetables.

Science

In science we will be exploring the topic Animals, including humans. We will identify animals and their offspring, describe animals development stages, and explore healthy life cycles

History

In History we will begin by learning about William the Conqueror and The Battle of Hastings. We will then look at the development of castles over time and explore who lives in them.

Art

In this unit children will revisit the technique of printing exploring a range of printing methods to build on their skills of block printing. They will use all 4 different techniques to design and create their own 4 part coat of arms, inspired by their topic Dungeons and Dragons.

PHSE/ RE

This term In RE we will be looking at 'Who is a Muslim?'. We will do this through research and questions such as; What do people think about God? Who was the Prophet Muhamma, and why is he important to Muslims? Along with many more questions.

PE

In PE this term, children will be learning how to roll, throw and kick balls through target games. We will also be looking at gymnastics through spinning, twisting and turning techniques.
