




Year 2: Spring 1 – Dungeons and Dragons

Big Bang Day – Wednesday 7th January

On the 7th January, year 2 will be having a special guest come in who will be talking about **dragons and related stories/activities**. We're excited for this fun and imaginative session!

English	We will start this term to look at our fiction text 'The Moon Dragons'. Using this book, we will explore how to innovate, imitate and apply our learning including creating our own dragons through descriptive writing.
Maths	We will start the term with a measurement unit, focussing on money. Children will expand their knowledge of notes and coins, as well as develop awareness of giving change and comparing amounts. We will then move onto multiplication and division where we will focus on 2s, 5s and 10s timetables.
History	In History we will begin by learning about William the Conqueror and The Battle of Hastings. We will then look at the development of castles over time and explore who lives in them.
Art/DT	In this unit, children will revisit the technique of printing exploring a range of printing methods to build on their skills of block printing. They will use all 4 different techniques to design and create their own 4-part coat of arms, inspired by their topic Dungeons and Dragons.
Music	We will continue to use Charanga to support the children's understanding of rhythm, tempo and melody.
Computing	We will be delving into the world of Artificial Intelligence - using AI to generate information, comparing and contrasting the information generated by AI and by humans, analyse and critique the information generate by AI and create, share and evaluate their own information products using AI.
RE and PD	This term in RE, we will be looking at 'How we should care for others and the world, and why it matters?' In PD, we will be looking at what it means to belong to a community and which communities we belong to, the different rights and responsibilities that they have in the school and wider community, how communities help people to feel included and recognise they are all equal.
PE	This term, children will be learning how to roll, throw and kick balls through target games. We will also be looking at gymnastics through spinning, twisting and turning techniques.
