All the World's a Stage

English	This term, children will be writing their own playscripts. This will be achieved by using the text, The Twits. Children will be using this text to write character descriptions, diary entries and ultimately a new playscript. Children will also be working at improving their grammar and punctuation
Maths	Place Value - This term we will be focusing on place value. They will be able to write and identify numbers up to 1000. They will round, compare, order and count up to 1000s. They will also begin to recognise and write negative numbers and Roman Numerals.
Science	In Science this term, we will focus on light. We will explore how light travels and different natural and man-made light sources. We will also be investigating how light reflects on different surfaces.
Geography / History	In History, year 4 will be exploring the history of theatre. We will be looking at and comparing theatre from a variety of ages, spanning from 55BC to current day. Areas of focus will include Greek, Roman, Elizabethan, and Musical theatre.
Art	This term, children will begin to improve their mastery of art and design techniques through sketching.
PHSE/RE	This term, the children will learn about Hinduism and what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today. In PSHE, they will be learning about health and relationships through examining different aspects of life encountered by a typical child today.
Music	In Music, children will be exploring the different types of music that have been used in the theatre.
