English

This term, children will be learning how to give a balanced argument, both in debates and written form. We will also be looking at historical fiction, exploring the techniques, language and vocabulary that makes it exciting and interesting.

Maths

Place Value - This term we will be focusing on place value. They will be able to write and identify numbers up to 1000000. They will round, compare, order and count up to 1000000. They will also be looking more closely at negative numbers and Roman Numerals.

Science

In Science this term will focus on Animals including humans. In this topic we will see how the body grows from gestation to old age and we will learn how these changes affect the body. We will also be comparing humans to other animals

Geography / History

In History, year 5 we will be looking at Tudor life. How they lived, died and explored in the world around them. We will find out all about how they changed the world, through the church, reformation, wars, exploration and innovation.

Art

This term, children will begin to improve their mastery of art and design techniques through modelling with plasticene and clay to create busts of famous people.

PHSE/RE

This term, the children will learn about how different people believe, or do not believe in God. In PSHE, they will be learning about health and relationships through examining different aspects of life encountered by a typical child today.
