

Year 6 Autumn 2: We'll Meet Again

Topic Overview - In this unit of work, students will explore WWII and the different events that eventually led to victory for the Allied Forces. Students will gain a deeper understanding of a world shaping event. They will learn about how World War 2 changed the political landscape of the world and of the resilience of everyday people during that perilous time.

Big Bang! In school: Year 6 children are invited to dress up as WW2 soldiers, evacuees, participating in an evacuation, eating rations that would have been popular at that time. We will learn about the lives of children during that time and start to develop an understanding of the different nations that took part in the war.

Our Learning Overview Key Text This term, our core text will be The Arrival by Shaun Tan. Children will be learning how to write a journey tale that grips the reader with empathy and emotion from the **English** point of view of an evacuee. We will also be writing a wishful letter from the family that the evacuee left behind. We will have shorter writing opportunities where we will be writing postcards to characters in the book. This term we will be focusing on the inverse link between multiplication and division. We will also be identifying lowest common multiples and factors as we gear up to learn about Maths fractions. In Science this term, children will explore parts of the eye and how each part works. Our Values They will look at how light reflects for us to see and how it can be refracted to create Science Teamwork optical illusions. ll Meet Again.
