	<u>Maths</u>	In Maths, we will continue developing our understanding of numbers within 10. We will begin to add and subtract numbers within 10 and will explore measurement, such as weight, length, volume and capacity. We will begin to look at shape, naming shapes and describing thier properties. Children will also have the opportunity to sort shapes, using their increasing knowledge of what the shapes are like.
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
