The audience included our KS2 classes, teachers, and parents. It was truly a magical time.

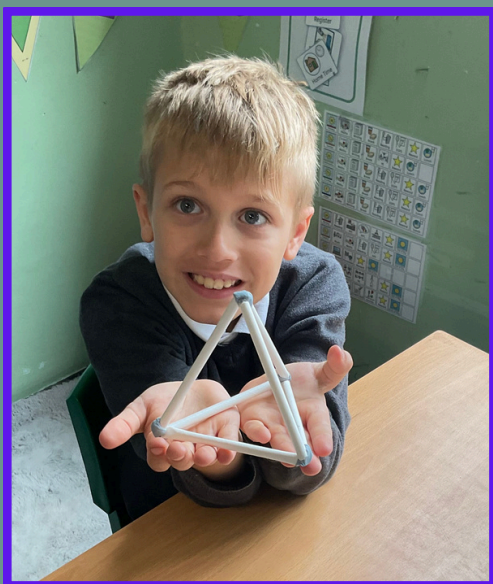


We would like to say a massive job well done to all the children and staff that took part in the performance and also a thank you to all the families that took time out to attend.

During this week maths lesson, Year 3 children explored 3D shape by building their own using straws.

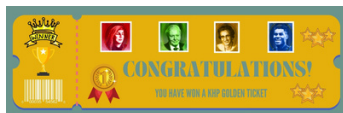


UKS2

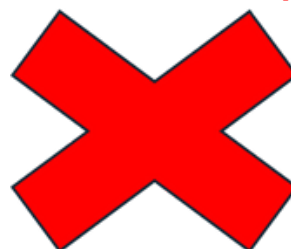

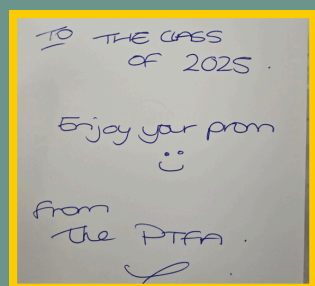
