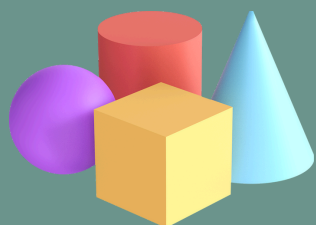
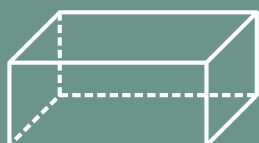
## KS1

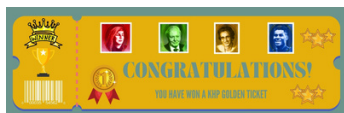
## UKS2
