WEEKLY GROUPS

Stay & Play: 0-5 years. This includes a variety of activities to support your child's learning and development. Messy activities will also be available for children to explore, we advise wearing old clothing.

Baby Group: For parents with babies who are not yet walking. This include a variety of activities to support your babies learning and development as they reach key milestones such as rolling, sitting and crawling.


