





Dear Families

It has been a busy week at Knockhall. The snow on Monday was a huge surprise especially for Toucans, Falcons and Flamingos who went to Wingham Zoo. The Year 2 classes had the Zoo to themselves and had the opportunity to take part in several different activities. Thank you to our Year 2 team and the parent volunteers for all their hard work to make the day such a success. One of our parents said, 'The children behaved beautifully and LOVED every minute of it.'

Cygnets and Owlets went to the library this week to choose some books for their classrooms.

They walked beautifully with their adults.

Hummingbirds and Robins had their Ukulele lessons this week which involved lots of strumming and picking of the strings to make unique sounds.

The Pantry came in and delivered a Sugar Smart Workshop to Kestrels and Woodpeckers. The children now understand sugar content in foods and how to make healthy choices.

We have received your feedback from the parent questionnaire and have begun working as a team to ensure that we listen to you and act where we can. Over the next few weeks, we will be giving you feedback on how we intend to improve things paying particular attention to comments made by you in the survey.

You Said -that you do not like the morning 'Drop Off', that there was congestion at the doors. We have made the following changes in response to this. From Monday 'Drop Off' will change. The Bus Stop Gate will be open from 8.30 for KS2 children and EYFS Gate will open for KS1 and EYFS children at 8.30 so that families can walk around to their child's playground/classroom.

- EYFS children will continue to be dropped off at their classroom door.
- Year 1 and 2 children will come through the EYFS Gate and be taken to the KS1 Playground
 where their teachers and support staff will be to greet them. Their own classroom will open
 at 8.40 for the children to line up and walk into school with their teaching team.
- Years 3,4,5 and 6 will come through the Bus Stop Gate and walk onto the KS2 playground where their class teacher and any support staff will be ready to greet them. They will line up and walk into their classroom at 8.40am.
- Children who are dropped off at our Drop Off Point will walk around to their Playground.
- There will be staff on both gates and at the Drop Off Point to support.
- Parents will exit the school using both gates when the bell is rung to signify the start of the school day.

I hope this new system helps with your concerns over morning drop off. We will continue to monitor things over the next few weeks and may make some tweaks if needed.

Thank you for your continued support and patience whilst we make these changes.

We are continuing to look at a variety of different nursery rhymes in Ducklings Class.



Climbed up the spout again.








We're going to the Zoo, Zoo, Zoo
