Down came the rain and washed the spider out.


Out came the sun and dried up all the rain,

# What have the children been learning this week in Reception ....


Christmas is coming! Reception have been lucky enough to watch and support other members of the school through watching their performances and have thoroughly enjoyed what they have seen.






# Parent's charity support for the Royal British Legion ....
