



Year 3: Autumn 2 – I Need a Hero

Big Bang Day – Tuesday 4th November

On the 4th November, children can come dressed as any kind of hero — from story characters to local service heroes or heroes from their own imagination.

Trip/ Visit

We are looking into a local community 'heroes' and hope to have guest speakers talk to our children.

English	Our children will be learning to create a first-person narrative from the perspective of Hogarth meeting the Iron Man. We will be focussing on suspense and creating character description using show not tell. In our non-fiction writing, we will be writing a newspaper report, using direct and indirect speech.
Maths	We will be continuing with addition and subtraction with a focus on adding and subtracting three-digit numbers including exchanging. We will then move on to multiplication and division focussing on the 3,4 and 8 times table.
Science	Our learning will focus on forces and magnets. We will be learning how a push or pull is exerted by something. We will also learn about magnets, how they're used and which materials are magnetic or non-magnetic.
History	We will be completing a local history study, looking at significant events which caused the beginning of the NHS, police force and the fire brigade. We will look at how these services have changed over time.
Art/DT	In this unit, children will build on their knowledge of primary and secondary colours to explore tertiary colours. Using Andy Warhol as their artist focus, they will create their own piece of art in the style of Andy Warhol, predicting which colours to mix to create their desired effect.
Music	The children will be introduced to subject specific vocabulary, using the glockenspiel to put their understanding into practice.
Computing	Children will be using iMovie and learning how to use green screen.
RE and PD	In RE, we will continue our learning around the question 'What do different people believe about God?' This will involve looking at different religions such as Hinduism, Islam and Christianity and learning about their similarities and differences. In PD, we will be looking at personal boundaries and how to safely respond to others. We will be discussing what makes a good friend and the impact of hurtful behaviour.
PE	We will be learning all about agility, how to move and control our bodies in different ways. Practicing moving safely around a space and being mindful of those around us. We will also be learning how to play tag rugby.
