Big Bang Day – Tuesday 4th November

On the 4th November, children will learn about Ancient Egyptians so please dress as pharaohs and queens. This could be: white or cream T-shirt or tunic (an old pillowcase with armholes works great!), add gold or yellow cardboard or paint on jewellery, collars, and headbands. Create a headpiece (for Pharaohs) or ribbon belts for queens.

English	This term pupils will be writing a historical tale using their knowledge of Ancient Egypt. They will also write a non-chronological report to showcase their knowledge of Ancient Egypt.
Maths	The topic is number - children will be focusing on multiplication and division. Children will learn how to use formal methods for this kind of work.
History	In History, we will be exploring the Ancient Egypt. We will be focusing on the location of Egypt globally and looking at key geographical features within Egypt as well as features of everyday life for a person living in that era.
Art/DT	This term, the children will further develop their drawing skills by accurately identifying and rendering 2D and 3D shapes when drawing from observation or second-hand sources.
Music	This term the children will be learning how to use the glockenspiel and will create Egyptian music.
Computing	The children will be designing a presentation and creating mock-ups for apps using Keynote.
RE and PD	This term, for RE the focus is Hinduism. Pupils will investigate what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today, including Diwali. In PD, this term the focus is on collaboration and teamwork. The children will work on this during their personal development session, through deep discussion to understand other feelings and thoughts.
PE	This term the children will be focusing on netball and tag rugby. The children will enhance their passing and shooting skills along with improving their ability to work as part of a team.
