We will continue to develop our reading skills by reading a wider range of texts linked to our topic and genre, and to Enalish practice and improve our spelling and handwriting skills. We will be looking more closely at how to use the four operations with decimal numbers before Maths moving on to negative numbers. In our final weeks we will convert different units of measurement before learning about volume, while continuing to use our skills to develop our reasoning skills and learning how these skills will help us in the future. <u>Our</u> Our topic this term is Living Things and their Habitats, building on our living things topic earlier in Values Science the year, we will develop our knowledge of animals to include single celled organisms including bacteria, fungi and viruses.
